Session Description including objectives and expected outcomes (500 words maximum):

Applying circular economy principles to water fosters water reuse, ensures more sustainable water flows in nature, recovers materials and energy from wastewater, reduces greenhouse gas emissions, creates business opportunities and enhances well-being. Nevertheless, governance obstacles related to regulation, finance and awareness need to be overcome to make circular water management a reality. This session will present lessons learned from circular water case studies and discuss options for the future. Beyond water operators and government players, the session will involve all relevant stakeholders of circular water management such as UN agencies, NGOs, water user associations, funding agencies, industrial actors, farmers and environmental groups.
