Actions and Outcomes	<p>Expected Outcome:</p> <p>Proposal of Cooperative Framework</p> <p>Creation of a cooperative framework to implement IWRM in small islands including SIS, SNIJ, and small islands within archipelagic states and delta countries will include an adaptation strategy to increase resilience against climate change risks. The cooperative framework will emphasize the local capacity development, technology approach, financial instruments, inclusiveness, and local knowledge/wisdom.</p> <p>Actions:</p> <p>Creating International and Bilateral Agreement or Declaration</p> <p>The instrument should consist of international and bilateral agreement on ensuring water sustainability in small islands. This agreement may incorporate climate change actions and management of recharge area to conserve water cycle in small islands. Furthermore, it may also consist of collaboration protocol between SIS, SNIJ, and small islands within archipelagic states and delta countries SIS.</p> <p>Development of a Guide for Water Finance Scheme</p> <p>The water finance scheme guide will cover the financing procedures for IWRM implementation on small islands. This action will depend on the results and agreements of the High-Level Panel meeting.</p>
