Session Description including objectives and expected outcomes (500 words maximum):

The world is not on track to achieve SDG 6. While access to water and sanitation services has improved, particularly in urban areas, challenges persist. They are particularly important in rural and disadvantaged areas, where access remains limited. With Billions of people still lack access to safely managed sanitation services, and water quality problems persist. Efforts are currently being made to address these challenges by increasing investment, innovation and partnerships to achieve the SDG 6 targets by 2030.

This session will focus on decentralized cooperation for the achievement of SDG 6 (and SDG 17). It will bring together local authorities at all levels, world leaders, NGOs and experts in the field of water and sanitation. As the world faces urgent challenges related to water scarcity, this peer-to-peer event will facilitate the exchange of experiences and best practices on innovative approaches to solving these problems at the local level.”
