HIGHLIGHTS OF THE DAY 3

OPENING : LOCAL, AND REGIONAL AUTHORITIES SEGMENT



Local and regional governments stand at the forefront of addressing water related challenges. The day-long participation of local and regional governments delved into aspects ranging from rethinking the value of water, to financing for water infrastructure and services. The intense discussions also led to a mutual agreement and a declaration between the World Water Council and UCLG (United Cities and Local governments)

OPENING : BASINS SEGMENT



The participants of the basin segment pledged to further consolidate the recognition of basin management as a political priority by making perennial the inclusion of a high level political segment dedicated to basins, alongside the "historic" Ministerial, Parliamentary and Local authorities segments.

DISCUSSIONS AND DELIBERATIONS



The third day of the 10th world water forum continued its efforts on discussions pertaining to the thematic and regional sessions. A sub-regional south East Asia synthesis session discussed the resilient and sustainable water scarcity management in south east asia.

The high level panel on "One-Health" highlighted the need for private sector collaboration and global energy proposed certain methods like desalination and water reuse as key solutions. The panel also pledged to reduce unused water, lowering electricity consumption, and implementing energy-efficient practices. 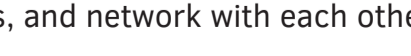
